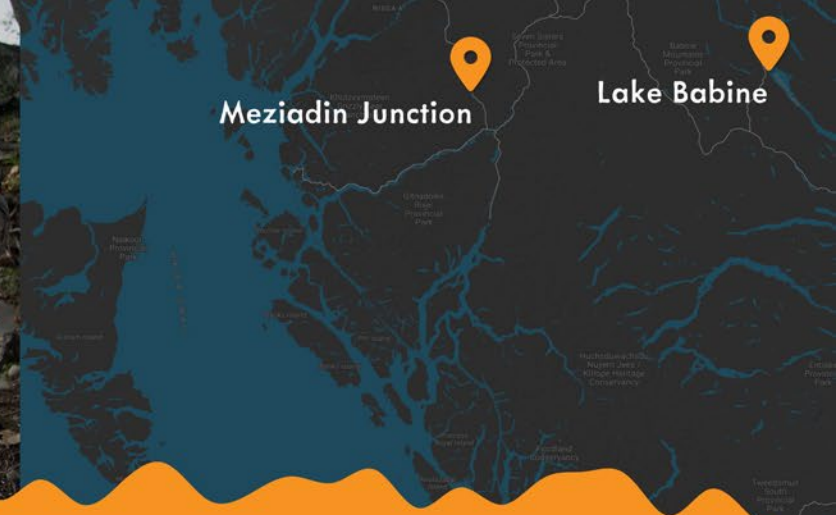


Traceability

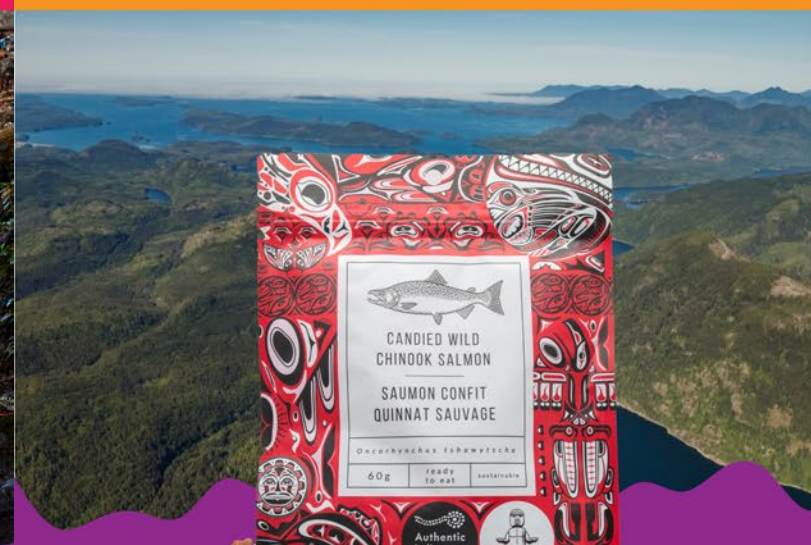

CANDIED WILD SOCKEYE SALMON

Indigenous fishery: Talok Fisheries & Gitanyow
Location: Lake Babine, BC & Meziadin Junction, BC

Most of the Gitanyow economic fishery on the Nass are caught on the Meziadin River, the largest Nass sockeye producing population, which usually makes up 75% of the total return. Gitanyow sockeye are caught at "Lax An Zok" which is one of their main traditional Meziadin River fishing locations. The fishery catches their salmon exclusively using dipnets as pictured above.

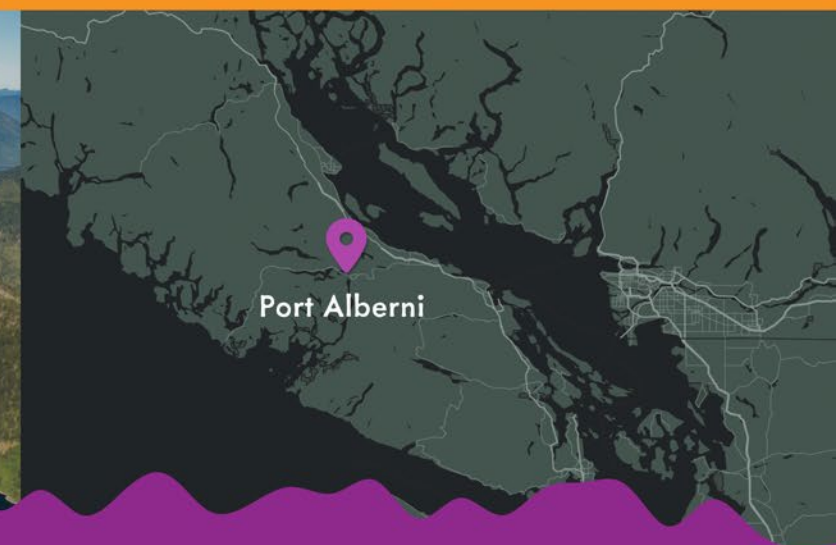

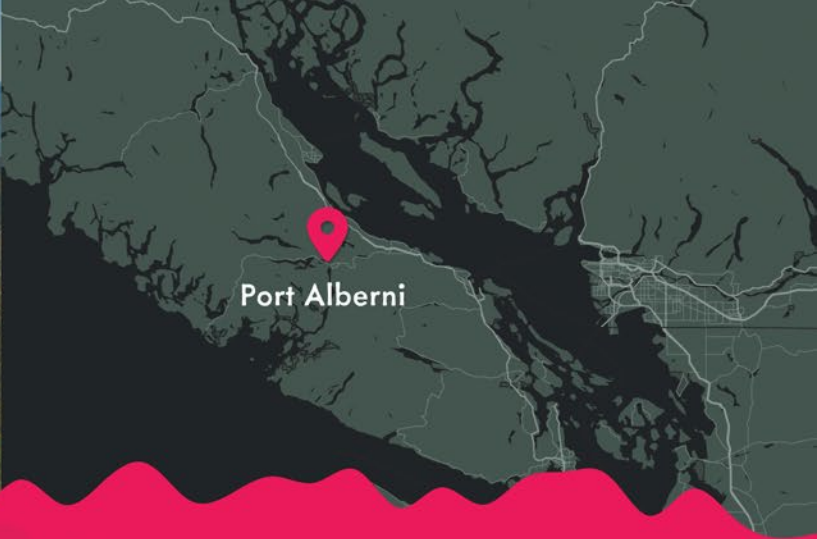


CANDIED WILD CHINOOK SALMON

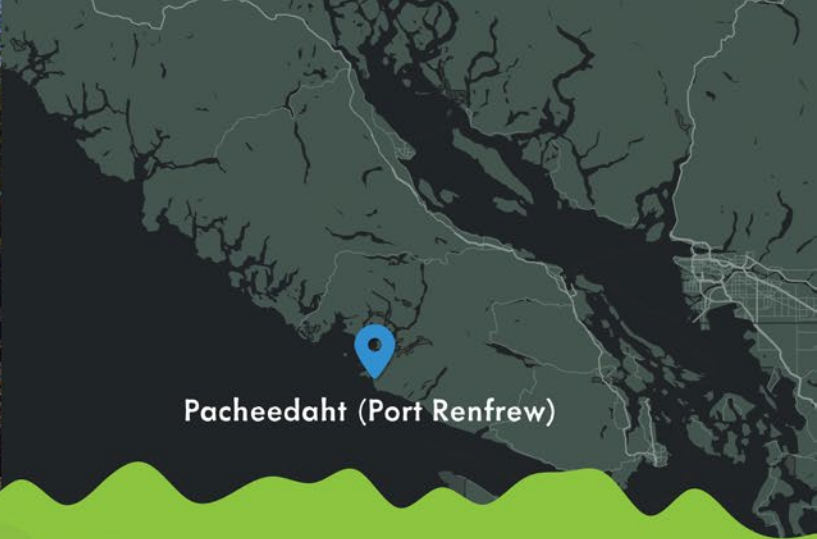

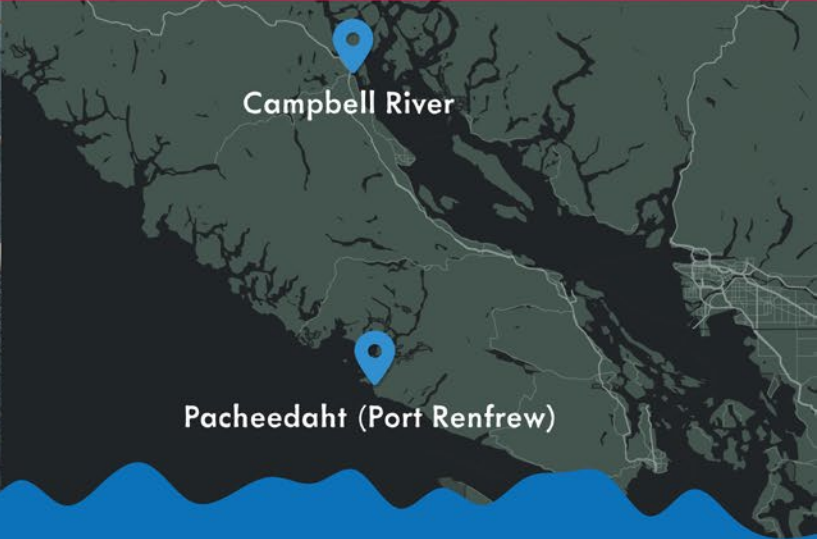

Seafoam's fisheries include a mix of salmon, groundfish, and shellfish, including Dungeness crab. Historically we were once whalers. Our fisheries programming includes both our modernized fish processing plant and smokery which are central to our brand, we are also responsible for a variety of salmon habitat restoration, stock rebuilding, assessment, and monitoring.

A-tlegay Fisheries Society is a collaborative effort of five member nations: We Wai Kai, Wei Wai Kum, K'omoks, Tlowitsis, and Kwiahah Nations. Founded in 1999, the society aims to enhance access and provide training support to facilitate the success of Indigenous fishers. A-tlegay focuses on building upon historical salmon and herring fishing patterns while improving fishery diversification and increasing commercial participation in their territorial waters.

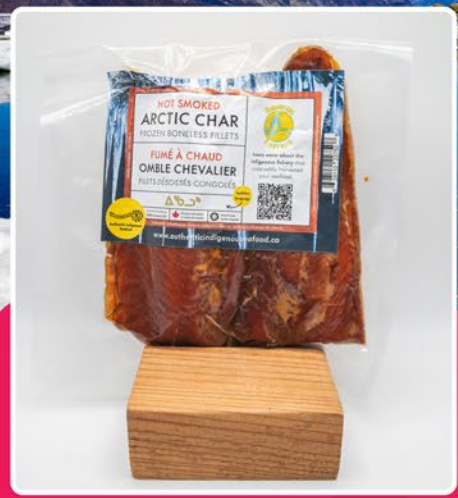
